On March 3, 2020, Ross Stores, Inc. (ROST) announced that its Board of Directors has approved an 11.8% increase in its quarterly cash dividend per share to \$0.285 (\$1.14 annually) from \$0.255 (\$1.02 annually). The dividend is payable on March 31, 2020 to shareholders of record March 17, 2020. With this increase announcement, Ross Stores has declared 26 consecutive annual dividend increases.

From the press release: Barbara Rentler, Chief Executive Officer said, “The increases to our shareholder payouts for 2020 reflect our ongoing confidence in the Company’s ability to generate significant amounts of cash after funding our growth and the other capital needs of our business. We have repurchased stock as planned every year since 1993 and raised our cash dividend annually since 1994. This consistent record reflects our ongoing commitment to enhancing stockholder value and returns.”

Ross Stores, Inc. is an S&P 500, Fortune 500, and Nasdaq 100 company headquartered in Dublin, California, with fiscal 2019 revenues of \$16.0 billion. The Company operates Ross Dress for Less® (“Ross”), the largest off-price apparel and home fashion chain in the United States with 1,546 locations in 39 states, the District of Columbia, and Guam at fiscal 2019 year-end. Ross offers first-quality, in-season, name brand and designer apparel, accessories, footwear, and home fashions for the entire family at savings of 20% to 60% off department and specialty store regular prices every day. The Company also operates 259 dd’s DISCOUNTS® in 19 states at the end of fiscal 2019 that feature a more moderately-priced assortment of first-quality, in-season, name brand apparel, accessories, footwear, and home fashions for the entire family at savings of 20% to 70% off moderate department and discount store regular prices every day.

Ross Stores, Inc. is in the Consumer Discretionary sector of our Dearborn Partners Core Rising Dividend separately managed account (SMA) portfolio. So far this year, 14 of the 49 companies in this portfolio have announced 14 dividend increases. The average of these dividend increases is about 8.6% more than these companies paid a year earlier. So far this year, no companies in this portfolio have decreased dividends.
