Another Dearborn Partners Core Rising Dividend SMA Portfolio Increase: Becton, Dickinson and Company

On November 4, 2021, Becton, Dickinson and Company (BDX) announced a 4.8% increase in its quarterly dividend per share to \$0.87 (\$3.48 annually) from \$0.83 (\$3.32 annually). The cash dividend will be paid on December 31, 2021 to holders of record as of December 10, 2021. This is the 50<sup>th</sup> consecutive annual increase in the dividend paid by Becton, Dickinson and Company.

From the press release: "Few companies have hit the milestone of a half century of consecutive dividend increases, and it is a source of pride to do so," said Tom Polen, chairman, CEO and president of BD. "The dividend increase and share repurchase authorization speak directly to BD's commitment to create value and return capital to shareholders, which are central outcomes to our BD 2025 strategy."
